

CAMP OF THE ULTIMATE WEAPON

Attached is a letter regarding the Camp of the Ultimate Weapon from the Camp Commander Ernie Kulhanek. We have modified the information to fit Lighthouse Baptist Church campers:

Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe that camp is almost here again! This year marks the 18th Annual Camp of the Ultimate Weapon! Camp is offered to 2-6 grade boys and girls. This year we will be holding camp at Penn Grove Retreat in Hanover, PA.

We will be meeting at the LBC at 9:00 am on Monday, August 2nd and returning Friday, August 6th at approximately 4:00pm.

We consider camp to be a time for the campers not only to have fun playing games but also a time to learn more about God. The leaders and counselors do their best to be a good Christian testimony to the campers. There are some rules the campers must abide by in order to help the camp run smoothly. We would appreciate it if you would review these rules with your child before camp starts and support our efforts in enforcing these same rules.

- Campers are expected to follow the dress code. Please refer to "WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP" flyer. NO radios, tape recorders, hand-held games, cell phones, I-pods, PSPs, MP3 players, etc. are permitted at camp.
- Campers are expected to respect others—not only the counselors, but other campers as well. Hitting, kicking, screaming at, making fun of, etc. other campers will not be tolerated.
- Campers are expected to use language that would be pleasing to the Lord. Therefore, no cursing, off-color stories or remarks will be tolerated. Campers are also asked not to wear clothing that represents worldly thing (example-a t-shirt that displays a rock group, etc.)
- Campers will be expected to follow the instructions of all leaders and counselors.

Due to the overwhelming response we have had to our camp program, we are registering campers on a first-come, first-served basis. A camper is not considered to be registered until the camp fee is paid in full. Space is limited, so please sign-up early. No registrations will be accepted after July 18, 2010.

The camp registration fee schedule is as follows: \$70 for one child, \$120 for two children, and \$140 for three or more children in the same family. Please complete the Camp Registration Form and return it with the necessary camp fee(s) as soon as possible to the LBC Office Mail Folder in the lobby. Please make all checks out to Middletown Baptist Church.
