Dear Parents,

Below is the pertinent information concerning **Winter Camp at Camp Calvary**. Please review all of the information carefully. We had a tremendous time last year at Winter Camp, and look forward to another great time this year.

The **registration fee of \$25** (made payable to Lighthouse Baptist Church) is **due on January 24, 2010**, along with the registration and medical authorization form (attached). The **remainder** of the camp fee (\$60) is due on **Sunday, February 14, 2010**. Your teen will want to bring **extra spending money** for snacks, paintball etc.

If your teen needs a permission or excuse form from our church in order to take off from school on Friday, please let Pastor Valiante know.

Departure from LBC / Arrival back to LBC

On **Thursday, February 18**, we will be **loading** the van at **4:20 pm** and will be **leaving** from Lighthouse Baptist Church at **4:35 P.M.** We will **arrive back** at the church on **Saturday, February 20 at 4:30 p.m.** The arrival time may fluctuate, so you will receive a phone call when we are approximately one hour away. If any changes in either our departure or arrival times occur, you will be notified.

I am attaching the **information** provided by Camp Calvary for you to **review** before sending your young person to camp. Please carefully review what each camper **should bring**, along with those items **prohibited**. Also, please pay close attention to the **standard of dress** required while at camp.

Note: Out of deference to Bensalem's Dress Standard, young ladies will not be permitted to wear jeans. All other types of pants are permitted.

You will receive a phone **call** when we **safely arrive** at Camp Calvary. The trip is approximately 2-2.5 hours, and would put our arrival at approximately 7:00 P.M. GENERAL INFORMATION

What to Bring: Sleeping bag or bedding, pillow, towels, toiletries, Bible, sports clothes, long pants for evening service, jacket, flashlight, sneakers, and spending money for snack shop, camp store craft shop, paintball and Go-Karts.

What NOT to bring: Tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, radios, CD/tape/MP3 players, CELL PHONES, computer games, TVs, magazines, knives, fireworks, any tight or short clothing, and NO animals of any kind.

CAMPER DRESS: In striving to maintain modesty, please use the following dress guidelines.

Girls:

Recreational Dress: Loose-fitting, hand width above the knee length or longer shorts; loose-fitting pants or capris; modest, loose-fitting tops. **No tank tops or sleeveless shirts of any kind.** **Girls are not permitted to wear jeans at camp.**

Evening Service Dress: Capris, pants or skirts (Same Length as shorts)

Boys:

Recreational Dress Loose-fitting, hand width above the knee shorts or loose-fitting pants, no muscle shirts of any kind.

Evening Service Dress: Jeans or pants and a collared shirt.

Both: Please avoid clothing with any inappropriate advertising.

***We reserve the right to request a change in any clothing or behavior deemed inappropriate.**

Christian Conduct: As a Christian organization, Camp Calvary maintains high standards of conduct and separation. Campers who use tobacco, alcohol or any form of illegal drugs will be discharged. Any campers who are uncooperative or non-compliant are subject to dismissal without refund.

First Aid: A health care provider will be on call as needed. Special instructions will be given at camp for those taking medications.

Lost & Found: Lost items not requested in two weeks' time will be discarded. Requested items will be mailed C.O.D.
